What are we doing?

In April we will need to implement a road closure on Dobbins Lane on the corner with High Street to carry out water main maintenance works.

These works will connect the water main to the Wendover Green Tunnel compound. The new water connection will reduce the number of deliveries to our sites, reducing the number of vehicles in the Wendover area.

While we do the work, we will be monitoring the water pressure to ensure we do not affect the water supply to Wendover town residents.

Due to the location of the water main access point we will need to close a small section of Dobbins Lane at the junction with Wendover High Street for six days to complete these works. A signposted diversion route will be in place.

When will these works take place?

The closure of a section of Dobbins Lane will be from Monday 22 April to Sunday 28 April.

Resident and business access will be maintained via the diversion route. The footpath will remain open for pedestrian traffic.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control but will be completed on or around the timings specified.

The footpath will remain open for pedestrian traffic.

Respond promptly to any complaints we may receive and action accordingly.



Where will the traffic management be?

The below maps shows where Dobbins Lane will be closed from Monday 22 to Sunday 28 April, a signed diversion route will be in operation throughout.

What stage of construction is the Wendover Green Tunnel at?

The earthworks phase of the construction of Wendover Green Tunnel has now begun, we are currently excavating to 3m above the ground water levels in the area where the green tunnel will be erected. We are currently waiting for further consents before continuing with bulk earthworks.

What will Wendover Green Tunnel look like?

The cut and cover tunnel will be approximately 1185m long with 120m portals at each end. The tunnel will be made up of pre-cast concrete twin arches which will be gradually widened at the end which will dissipate the air as the train enters to avoid a sonic boom effect. The use of pre-cast concrete will reduce traffic and noise impact in the local area.




Image above shows artist impression of what the completed Wendover Green Tunnel will look like.
